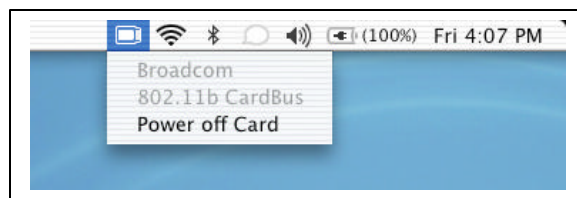

### **Note:**

- AL5402-XG does NOT require any driver installation when operating under Apple Macintosh computers running Mac OSX Panther and later. The AL5402-XG is supported natively within the OS; thus, no driver installation is needed. Follow the hardware installation instructions from the included Quick Start Guide to properly install the AL5402-XG adapter, then configure and operate the adapter the same way as an Apple AirPort Extreme adapter.
- Macintosh Users: To turn power off the PC card, select "Power off Card" from the PC Card menu extra, which is visible when a PC Card is inserted and active.



- In order to transfer data at IEEE 802.11g (54 Mbps) speed, the AL5402-XG II has to be connected to an IEEE 802.11g wireless network. If it is connected to an older IEEE 802.11b wireless network, the AL5401-XG will still function correctly but the data transfer rate will be limited 11 Mbps (802.11b spec).
